

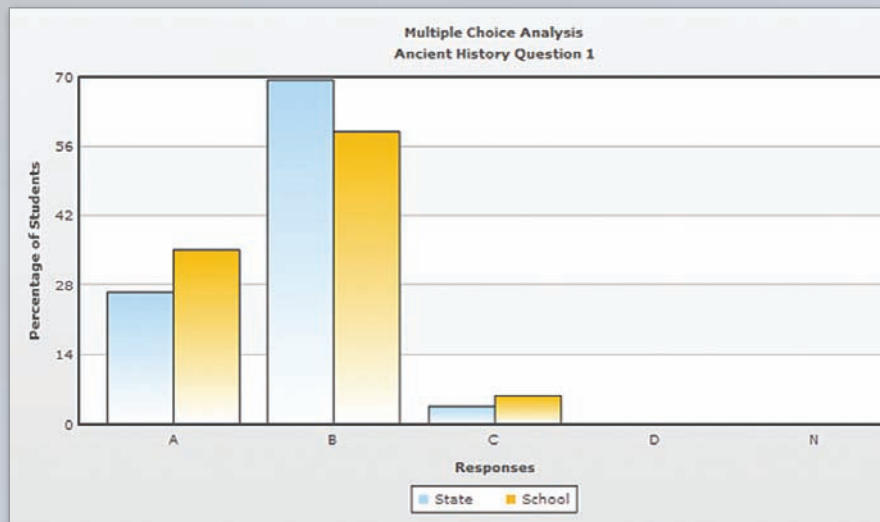
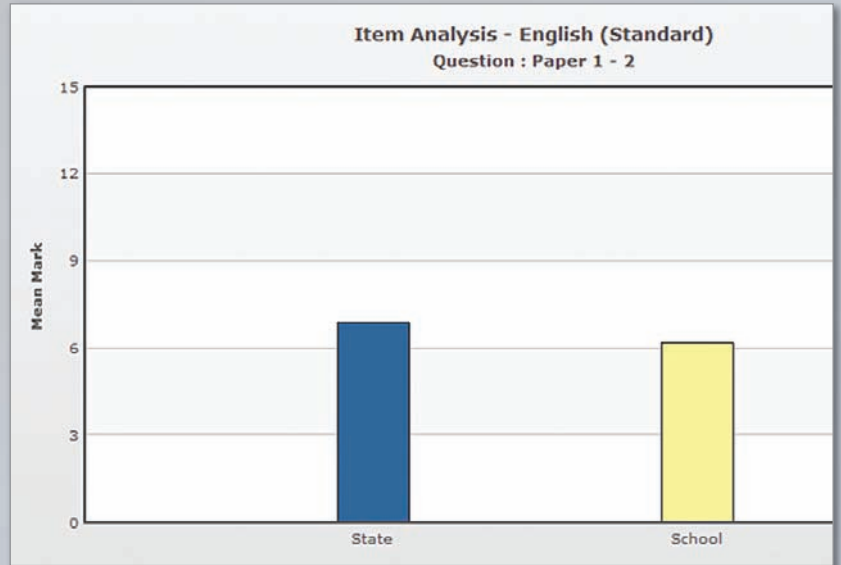

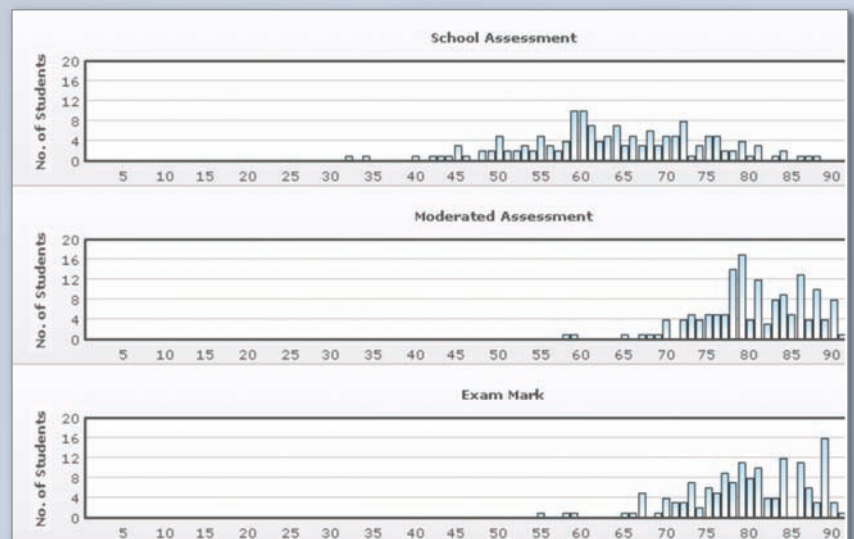

- The Item Analysis allows schools to make comparisons between a school and state on a whole of question or project basis, so schools can compare their students' performance on projects to the mean state performance.



- Multiple-choice data is shown with the relative performance of students at the various bands depicted in a way that encourages further exploration and research.
- On most screens, hovering over the graphs enables numerical data contained in the graph to be displayed.

- View all your students' HSC statistics (school assessment, moderated assessment and exam marks) for each course on one screen.
- Data can be exported to a spreadsheet to enable further analysis to enhance teaching and learning in schools.

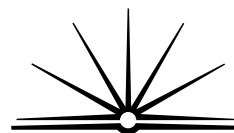
